THE ISSUE IS WHETHER AMERICA WILL HAVE  
A POLITICAL PARTY COMMITTED TO  
AFFIRMING VALUES GOD GAVE MAN TO LIVE  
BY.

From 1787 to 1947, 160 years, if you asked the leaders  
of the influential elite's in America what the  
cornerstone was for the American experiment in  
self-government, most would respond the Bible, the  
Old and New Testament, the Judeo Christian ethic.

These elite's include, the Clergy, Medicine, Academia,  
Judiciary, the Media, Business, Labor and the two  
major political parties.

Atheistic forces set forth their agenda for America - to  
remove the influence of religion from our culture - in  
the Humanist Manifesto in 1933. It was a declaration  
of Atheism.

The game plan included taking over the direction of  
government schools in America. Read the agenda of  
the National Education Association. It is a major  
battleground in the cultural war waging in America.

The Judiciary of America, particularly at the federal  
level, was also a target for conquest of this atheistic  
movement.

In 1947, the U.S. Supreme Court obliged by writing a  
myth into an opinion. Separation of Church and  
State.

Our founding fathers meant by the First Amendment,  
Freedom of Religion not Freedom from Religion.

Subsequent decisions of the U.S. Supreme Court and  
other courts in the ensuing 49 years have stolen the  
religious heritage on which the nation was founded.

The consequences to our culture have been  
devastating.

Following the Judicial rejection of natural law and the  
embracing of Relativism, the United States has  
become number one in the world in violent crime,  
divorce, and illegal drug use; number one in the  
Western World in teenage pregnancies, and number  
one in the Industrial World in illiteracy. While  
America has always been a world leader, since  
1962-1963 it have been leading in many of the wrong  
categories. Relativism and Positivism have not  
produced national betterment or prosperity, but rather  
their opposites!

The new Census Bureau data are shocking, although  
not unexpected, in one decade, from 1982 to 1992, the  
rate of illegitimate births soared from 15.8% to 24.2%,  
an increase of more than half — the largest increase  
ever.

For comparison, the illegitimacy rate was about 3% in  
1950 and 4% in 1960.

The new levels are highest among African-Americans  
(rising from 49% to 67%) and Hispanics (16% to

27%). But it is a national problem. The illegitimacy  
rate grew most rapidly among whites (10% to 17%).

A single question needs to be asked on this issue: Who  
authorized the U.S. Supreme Court to steal the  
Christian Heritage on which the nation was founded?

Answer, no one!

Thomas Jefferson expressed his concern about the  
federal judiciary with the following language:

"It has long, however, been my opinion, and I  
have never shrunk from its expression...that the  
germ of dissolution of our federal government is  
in the constitution of the federal judiciary,  
...working like gravity by night and by day,  
gaining a little today and a little tomorrow, and  
advancing its noiseless step like a thief, over the  
field of jurisdiction, until all shall be usurped."

Those Justices of the U.S. Supreme Court who have  
participated in this theft of our heritage should be  
impeached by Congress.

The platform of the Republican Party should make  
this very clear.

On the Pro-life issue the Republican Party platform  
for 1996 should continue on the course described in  
1992.

"We believe the unborn child has a fundamental  
individual right to life which cannot be infringed.  
We therefore reaffirm our support for a human  
life amendment to the Constitution, and we  
endorse to make clear that the Fourteenth  
Amendment's protections apply to unborn  
children. We oppose using public revenues for  
abortion and will not fund organizations which  
advocate it. We commend those who provide  
alternatives to abortion by meeting the needs of  
mothers and offering adoption services. We  
affirm our support for appointment of judges
